Therefore, providing children with an environment that supports their holistic development is essential.

The "Pre-school" wing is the latest addition to NCCS, located within its school premises, starting from the academic session 2078. Currently, we have 31 enthusiastic little children who love coming to school every day, excited and eager to learn and enjoy their entire day.

At Pre-School, we offer a curriculum that combines both play-based and academic activities for our learners. Play-based activities help transform children into curious and enthusiastic learners who find joy in learning in their own unique ways. Simultaneously, academic activities lay the foundation of discipline and encourage children to focus on academics as they progress to the primary level. Our programs also include teaching children about our seasonal festivals, culture, and community traditions. Additionally, we conduct dance and music classes to foster confidence, artistic and creative skills, and language development.

Eligibility Criteria For Admission

Secondary level (+2 Level)

The eligibility criteria for the admission to +2 level are:

- Students who have passed the Secondary Education Examination (SEE) or an equivalent examination are eligible to apply.
- Applicants must have obtained a minimum grade (B for Science stream / C+ for Management stream) in the SEE or equivalent examination aggregate.
- SEE or equivalent examination grade sheet and SEE Character certificate

After completing the Secondary Education Examination (SEE), NCCS offers a range of courses to its students. NCCS started with Plus 2 in Management stream but now the institution has added Plus 2 in Science stream too.

School Timings

There is a designated lunch break provided by the school to ensure students have time to eat and recharge.

After the regular school hours, there is a snacks break for the students to have a quick refreshment. Following the snacks break, special tutorial classes are conducted until the last bell, which is around 4:45 pm. The timings are the same for all the students and staff. These tutorial classes are aimed at providing additional support to students, helping them with their homework, and focusing on their weaker subjects. The tutorial classes may vary in nature, such as special classes, club classes, or extracurricular activities (ECAs), depending on the schedule.

During the winter season, the school timings are slightly lessened. The school starts at the regular time of 8:15 am but continues until 4:15 pm, allowing for the adjustment of daylight hours.



Health Care
